A Consulting Arborist should provide Preliminary Arboricultural Assessment of trees on a site, input to minimise impacts at design stage and Arboricultural Impact Assessment reports for submission to the consent authority, as well as involvement on site throughout works to advise on tree protection measures and work methods.

Accredited IACA members work to ensure that tree protection and sustainability are central to urban development. Early involvement of an Arboriculturist not only facilitates compliance and enhances environmental outcomes but also streamlines the approval process, making project implementation smoother and more cost-effective.

### MEMBERSHIP

IACA categories of membership welcome a wide array of professionals into the fold. Membership allows for involvement and collaboration with fellow professionals, aiming to improve the skills,

knowledge and work practices of all arboriculturists, and forward focused members of related professions.

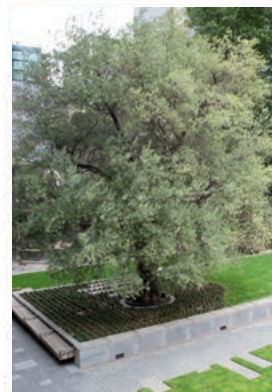
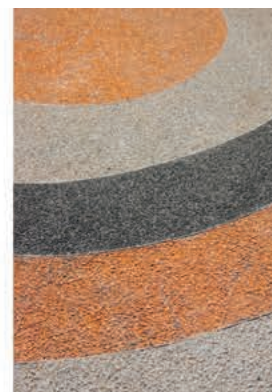

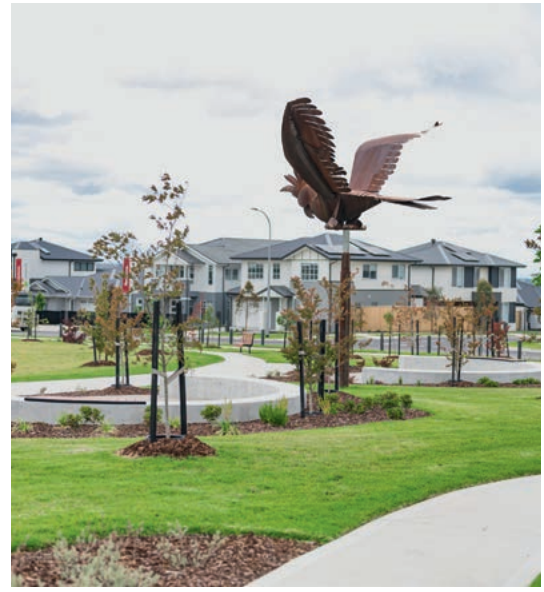
